

## Communication

All essential information about the IEO 2022 is provided to the participants via e-mail campaigns and WhatsApp chats.

For the whole duration of the IEO 2022, each team is assigned a volunteer who provides informational support and helps with organizational and technical issues. Each team has a chat with the assigned volunteer on WhatsApp for effective communication.







The IEO 2022 major news is published in the IEO 2022 Broadcast chat on WhatsApp that all participants should join via the invitation link sent from <a href="mailto:info@ecolymp.org">info@ecolymp.org</a>. Participants can discuss the Olympiad and other topics in the IEO 2022 Official Chat.

## **Ceremonies**

The Opening and Closing Ceremonies will take place on the online platform ceremony.ecolymp.org. To use the chat on the platform, participants complete the registration using their account on Google or social media.

Note: final results are NOT announced prior to the Closing Ceremony.

### **Technical Instructions for Rounds**

### **Economics Test & Financial Literacy**

Financial Literacy and Economics parts will be held in the form of an online proctored exam on the IEO testing platform <u>contest.ecolymp.org</u>.

You will be sent an email containing your login and password by July 20. Use these data to log in on <u>contest.ecolymp.org</u>. Confirm your registration by changing the password and complete your profile. Take the Technical Test at the recommended time.

During the IEO, you will have to use cameras of two devices (a PC/laptop and a smartphone).

#### **Exam Checklist**

Make sure you have completed the Technical Test before the start of the Olympiad.

#### Prepare:

- ID Card with name and photo
- Steady internet connection
- Computer/laptop on the charge for tests
- Smartphone on the charge for proctoring

#### Restrictions:

- No talking or singing
- No extra devices
- No third persons in the room (except for your teammates and team leader if the team has selected the single-room proctoring option)
- Notifications must be switched off

#### Allowed:

- Scratch paper and a pen
- Snacks (chocolate, fruit etc.) and water (the wrapping must be off)
- Chatting with the proctor on technical issues

### **Economics: Specific Rules**

The only webpage you are allowed to visit during Economics Part is: Dictionary – <u>translate.google.com</u>

NOTE! You will see the tasks in the following order:

- 1. 20 multiple-choice questions (80 minutes)
- 2. 5 open questions (155 minutes)

Between the two parts, you will have a 30-minute break to cover your physical needs. You will not be able to go back to multiple-choice questions after the break starts; you will not be able to have a break while working on questions.





Make sure you have checked your replies before switching to the next part of the round.

### **Financial Literacy Game: Specific Rules**

For Financial Literacy Game, you will receive your personal login and password via email: please insert this data after opening the webpage from the Financial Literacy Game element on <u>contest.ecolymp.org</u>. You can only use the latest version of the Google Chrome browser. It is recommended to play the Demo version of the game before the competition.

During the exam, make sure you do not change your focus to other applications or browser tabs. You may use the pre-printed <u>Game coefficients</u> with your notes on them.

#### **Technical Issues**

In case there are technical issues that prevent the participant from completing the test (connection/electricity failure), the Jury assesses the results received before the participant left the system.

To avoid technical issues, follow the recommendations:

- 1) Check your equipment according to the instructions in «Minimum Requirements». In case you have trouble with configuration, turn to <u>F.A.Q</u> that contains solutions to the most common problems;
- 2) Complete the Technical Test and play the Demo version of the Financial Literacy Game in order to learn the interface and the general functions of the suggested platforms;
- 3) Use fully-charged devices: if possible, leave them on the charger for the whole duration of the exam;
- 4) If possible, use a laptop and not a computer in order to prevent being disconnected from the network due to electricity shortcuts and/or any similar problems.

### **Business Case**

The Business Case lasts for two days:

- 1) day of preparation;
- 2) day of the presentation.

During the day of preparation, contestants may use any online and offline materials, but it is prohibited to contact other people for help. All teams submit their slides by 23:59 UTC, 29 July. No changes to slides are allowed after this time.

On the day of presentation, teams are divided into groups. Each group is assigned a separate panel of judges and a volunteer. The team is allowed to present from different locations but each team member should turn on the camera. The slides are broadcasted from the volunteer's computer. The control of the slides is given either to the volunteer or to one of the team members. Should the team choose the latter option, they are to discuss which contestant is going to control the slides via Zoom remote control function and indicate that to the volunteer when asked prior to the presentation.

The top team from each group is invited to the public Business Case Finals. In the Finals, teams are to present their solution again and be graded by a panel of judges.


## Moderation

On 30 July, contestants and team leaders gain access to the solutions and grades for Economics. They can compare each solution to the grading parameters published in advance and prepare to discuss the marks with the Jury. On the same day, the Steering Committee launches a form to collect requests for moderation.

To help the Jury find the works of the contestants and to be able to reevaluate the marks given, we recommend to prepare the following information in advance:

- The contestant's name:
- Tasks, numbers of tasks to be reviewed;
- Grading parameters;









• Contestant's solution with the parts of the solution that were not evaluated in accordance with those parameters underlined.

Please note that the prepared information is to be used to aid the team's representative in the oral moderation process and cannot be submitted in writing.

On 31 July, representatives of teams present their arguments in defence of contestants' solutions before the Jury. The Jury members are distributed in several rooms in accordance with the number of moderation requests for each question and their specialization in particular questions.

Each team is given 20 minutes which can be spent in one or several rooms and can be devoted to the discussion of any number of solutions. The schedule of moderation is published on the day of the event once all the teams submit their requests. Each team will be assigned a particular entrance time based on their region (Asia — Europe/Africa — Americas).

The time keeper in each room will warn about the time limit and fix the result of reevaluation and the time spent in each room. It is strongly recommended to base the defence on the grading parameters that include strict rules on what mark should be set according to the text of the contestant's solution.

The grades will be updated on the platform by 31 June, 23:00 UTC.
