



IEO 2023 Single Room Exam Instructions

Online Participation

In case the online Team chooses to take part in the proctored rounds with the contestants located in the same examination room, the following configuration of the equipment is required:

1. Contestant's individual workplace

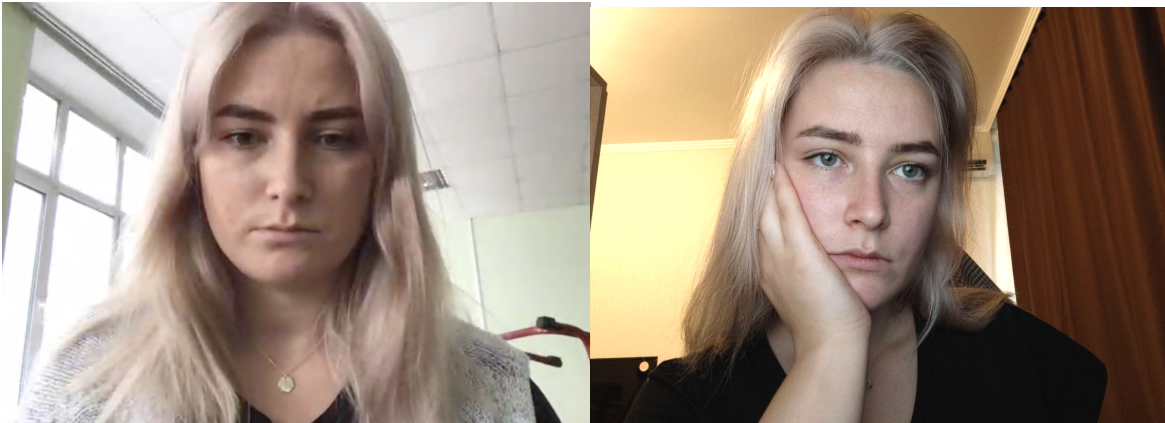
- 1.1. Contestant's individual workplace should be equipped with a computer/laptop with a web camera, stable Internet connection and pre-installed Google Chrome browser (the latest version). The technical requirements for the devices are provided in the [Contestant Guidance](#).
- 1.2. Each contestant must have a fully charged smartphone with a pre-installed QR-code reader that would enable them to switch on the second camera. All the rules described in the Technical Instruction apply.

2. Examination room

- 2.1. The examination room should be spacious enough to accommodate all contestants and a team leader with a minimum distance of 2 meters between each pair of people.
- 2.2. The Zoom camera should be placed in the corner of the room and cover all the contestants, the team leader and the entrance. In case one camera cannot provide the required image, a second camera is applied and placed in a way that leaves the rest of the contestants in the frame.
- 2.3. The link to the Zoom room is sent to the team leader by IEO Steering Committee no later than 25 July 21:00 UTC.

3. Camera's frame

- 3.1. *Contestant's web camera:*



3.1.1. The face is well-lit and visible.

3.1.2. The sight is directed to the screen.

3.2. *Contestant's second camera:*



3.2.1. The hands and the keyboard of the contestant are clearly seen.

3.2.2. The face of the contestant fits into the frame.

3.3. *Zoom camera covers all the seats and the entrance.*



Note: During the proctored rounds, communication in any language but English is strictly prohibited and will lead to disqualification of the contestant.

Participation from the Greece Venue

In 2023, the Distributed Hosting system is applied. If the team takes part in the proctored rounds at the official IEO Venue, the webcam and the additional smartphone camera are not used since the examination rooms are invigilated by the international community of team leaders, observers and volunteers. The following rules are applied:

1. Contestant's individual workplace

- 1.1. Contestant's individual workplace should be equipped with a computer/laptop with stable Internet connection and pre-installed Google Chrome browser (the latest version).

2. Examination room

- 2.1. The examination room should be spacious enough to accommodate all contestants with a minimum distance of 2 meters between each pair of people, and their invigilators.
- 2.2. The Zoom camera should be placed in the corner of the room and cover all the contestants, the invigilators and the entrance. In case one camera cannot provide the required image, a second camera is applied and placed in a way that leaves the rest of the contestants in the frame.
- 2.3. The link to the Zoom room is sent to the Venue representatives by IEO Steering Committee no later than 25 July 21:00 UTC.
- 2.4. Zoom camera



2.4.1. The camera covers all the seats and the entrance.

Note: During the proctored rounds, communication in any language but English is strictly prohibited and will lead to disqualification of the contestant.
