






## SECOND CAMERA: EXPECTED VIEW










#### SECOND CAMERA: POOR VIEW


















## JOIN IN ADVANCE!



- opening any extra web pages or applications
- using headphones, physical calculator or any other extra devices
- leaving your seat
- chatting with other people (except for your proctor / Venue volunteer)
- switching off the cameras (for online participants)
   or screen sharing (for everyone)
- placing the second (mobile) camera in a way that leaves you and your workplace out of the frame




- Preview only visualizes one formula at once: if you insert or select several formulas, it will not work.

#### Sketch and Save



If you add lines and figures, don't forget to convert the layer to raster. To do so, go to Layers → Convert to raster. Without this conversion, you will not be able to save the sketch nor erase the parts that you want to

disappear.

The "Insert Sketch" button is located at the bottom of your screen. To see it, hide the bottom banner connected to screensharing (use the "Hide" button).
