













IEO ON MAP

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

HOW TO JOIN

To send a national delegation to the IEO, an institution needs to complete the two steps:

HOLD THE NATIONAL SELECTION


Organize a nationwide competition to select the finalists

APPLY FOR PARTICIPATION

Complete the application form with information on the sending organization and the national selection



MAJOR DEADLINES



After one year of participation, the organization may apply for a three-year exclusive partnership with the IEO.

REQUIREMENTS

- The national competition serving as the IEO selection process is expected to include at least one of the three IEO disciplines **Economics, Financial Literacy, or Business Case** or a combination of these areas. The national team for the IEO should be chosen primarily based on the results in these parts, while **English proficiency** may also be taken into account.
- The competition should be open and accessible to all individuals who meet the IEO participation criteria that is, **high-school students or recent graduates under 20 years old as of 30 June** in the year of the Olympiad. In the case of multi-stage competitions, this principle applies at least to the first stage.
- The **governing document** of the competition (such as a Statute or equivalent) should express a clear **commitment to fairness, openness, and transparency** throughout the selection process.
- The competition is encouraged to maintain **no or minimal participation fees** for contestants. The timeline of all stages should be planned and communicated at least three months in advance.

BENEFITS

SPECIALIZED PLATFORM

The ANS rounds take place on the IEO testing platform — the same that the IEO finalists compete at. The platform is equipped with the necessary tools for smoother testing experience.

FAIRNESS

The ANS rounds are fairly invigilated: depending on the package, each contestant is observed by a room volunteer or an online proctor.

PROFESSIONAL JURY

The tasks are composed by the IEO Problem Committee. The papers of the final round are graded by the experts of the IEO Community.

CREDIBILITY

All ANS events take place under the joint branding of the IEO and the National Organizer combining reputational strengths of both institutions.



Within the IEO platform, contestants are provided with all the necessary tools, including an online dictionary and a calculator.


Every step of participation is accompanied by a detailed instruction — both in textual and video format.



PROCTORING




